

The Discover Woodstock Scavenger Hunt is a free activity that will take participants on a journey through Woodstock. This event consists of 100 challenges where the participants must take creative photos of various things. We understand that you may not finish all 100, so challenges are scored by degree of difficulty. Choose wisely!

Submissions will be accepted throughout the event (August 30th- September 15th) at the Woodstock Visitors Center (Mon.-Sat. 10-5)! Bring your digital camera, cell phone or whatever device used to take photos to the Woodstock Visitors Center. Participants are encouraged to bring pictures downloaded to a USB or flash drive (5 bonus points). Judges will examine pictures to score the scavenger hunt results. You may also bring hard copies to be scored if you prefer.

Rules:

- When you turn your results in, a team name is required for scoring
- No repeat photos.
- No combining multiple tasks into one photo.
- Every member of a team must be in each photo except the member taking it (no dividing and conquering!)
- Be respectful in everything you do.
- Include logos of places you go so we know you actually went!
- Respect private property.
- FOLLOW ALL TRAFFIC LAWS, FEDERAL LAWS AND ALL OTHER LAWS!!
- Be Creative!!!

- Georgia Top 100 sticker on the door of Freight Kitchen & Tap
- Checking out a statue of a turkey in Downtown Woodstock
- Enjoying a view of Little River while standing on the pedestrian bridge at Rope Mill Park
- Charlie Angels pose in front of the Chamber Street mural
- At Madisonn Ave come take a picture with their big blue chair!
- Trying your luck at the Big Bass Wheel at Stars & Strikes
- Take a picture with the Moore's Pass Trail sign
- At the Wright Stuff this antique item will help make sure you add up any purchases you might make.
- Woodstock Medical Pioneers plaque at the Park at City Center

- Bowling at Stars & Strikes
- At this spot in the Outlet Shoppes you can take a ride on a Helicopter, take a picture with the copter
- Resting on the bench on the Towne Lake Pass Trail where the trail dead ends into a road.
- Pigs do fly at a certain spot in Downtown Woodstock. Take a picture with the visual proof
- With the Little Free Pantry in Downtown Woodstock
- Dupree Park features a Frisbee Golf Course. Take a picture at #11 on the course

- 560 sign on the Explorer Trail
- At the Elm Street Event Green find Flight Pattern and take a picture with it
- Historically the poultry industry has been a very important part of the Cherokee County economy. Which is why at The Circuit you will find a sign featuring Chicken and Eggs. Take a picture with the sign
- Watching a dog/s play at Woofstock Park
- Reading a sign about the history of chairs at a historic spot in Woodstock
- With the turbine trail head sign
- Take a picture at Friday Night Live "Art Night" while you are checking out an art vendor or art activity
- Get your picture taken while flapping your wings like a duck in front of the ducks & geese at Dupree Park
- Striking the yoga "tree" pose in front of Ember Hot Yoga
- With 2 koalas at the Woodstock Visitors Center
- Relaxing on the section of the Rubes Creek Trail that features 3 benches
- With a plaque marking the past site of a livery stable in Downtown Woodstock
- Snap, Sparkle & Change Take your Photo by This at House & Garden Boutique
- Reading the Woodstock Brochure while Riding the Woodstock Trolley
- With picture of Elizabeth Johnston hanging in the Georgia Room at the Woodstock Public Library
- With a plaque dedicated on July 4th, 1998 at the Park at City Center
- Take a photo pretending to be a Pie Bar Team Member While Enjoying a Slice of Pie behind the counter. *ask permission from a staff member to go behind the counter to take a picture for the scavenger hunt

- (Extra points if you can get the team member to pretend to scold you for eating pie when you should be working)
- A shirt that you can purchase at the Woodstock Visitors Center is also featured in the new Woodstock Mural. Take a picture of you pointing out the shirt in the mural
- At the end of the Trestle Rock Trail checking out the view of Little River
- At Sweet River Rough River find the bath bomb that is shaken, stirred, or _____
- This building is not green but if you look hard enough you will discover a green brick on the building's main side

Photos worth 3 points:

- With the Rock Garden sign on the Powerhouse Trail
- A kid dropped some lollipops while they were having fun alongside Mill Street. Take a picture with the lollipops that were dropped on the ground
- Sign 440 on the Avalanche Trail
- This Salon can be found next to a location that is a center of activity in Woodstock. The first letter in the city's name will help sure you find the right salon. Take a picture in front of it
- Find T Dean at the Woodstock Visitors Center and take a picture with
- Richard & Emity are On the Noonday Creek Trail, take a picture with them
- At the Wright Stuff this toy offers a C View, find it and take a picture of it
- Canoe/Kayak on Little River at Rope Mill Park
- Enjoying at Race at Dixie Speedway
- On the Towne Lake Pass Trail a rock bridge goes over the trail. Take a picture with the bridge in the background

- Listening to the live music at a Brown Bag Concert at the Park at City

 Center
- Tom Collins is featured at the Woodstock Visitors Center. Take a picture with
- With the "Caution Rock Feature" sign on the Avalanche Trail
- "May you always have a book in your hand and your toes in the sand" is a sign you can discover at a park in the City of Woodstock, Take a picture with it
- Not the building you would expect to discover a Mountain Bike at but if you visit the right place you will be able to take a picture with a bike mounted on a wall
- Trail Ends 100 ft sign on the Rubes Creek Trail
- Enjoying a concert at Madlife Stage & Studios
- Dupree Park features a Frisbee Golf Course. Take a picture at #15 on the course
- On the Raceway Trail you will discover a ghostly white tree trailside, the tree is closer to the section of the trail you would start on as a hiker if it is Wednesday. Take a picture with the tree
- Find the "Welcome to Woodstock" brick by the fountain at the Park at City

 Center and take a picture with it
- With survey mark near sign 7 at Rope Mill Park
- At the Circuit find the sign for Vision Stairways & Millwork and take a picture with it
- With a rectangle shaped rock on Loop 2 of the Explorer Trail that is within sight of a body of water

- On the Towne Lake Pass Trail posing next to the creek at the section of the trail that is between two yellow concrete structures
- With the 900 sign at the Powerhouse Trail
- On the Explorer Trail take a picture with the "ed0" sign, Not sure what sign that is? Well we have come up with a code and you just have to decode "ed0" to figure out which sign we are referring to. Happy Decoding!

Bonus Points

1 bonus point will be added if:

- A team member tweets @DTWoodstock using #DiscoverWoodstock with your favorite picture from the scavenger hunt, include your team name
- A team member tags us on Instagram using #DiscoverWoodstock with your favorite picture from the scavenger hunt, include your team name
- Team members bring receipts for any purchase made during the timeframe of the event from a downtown store or restaurant, \$10 minimum purchase (1 point per restaurant receipt, 2 points per retail store receipt)

3 bonus points will be added if:

- A team turns in a video they took during the hunt. Video can be turned in on usb drive with photos from Scavenger Hunt. Video should focus on why your team loves Woodstock or on why people should visit Woodstock. Minimum video length is 30 seconds and video should not exceed 5 minutes in length. Videos will be judged on creativity, quality, and overall awesomeness. Judges will review videos turned in and select the three best videos. The top 3 videos will

earn extra bonus points. Best Video will earn 12 extra bonus points, 2nd Best will earn 8 extra bonus points, and 3rd Best will earn 4 extra bonus points
