Woodstock, Georgia, has many exciting and fun outdoor amenities to offer. If you love the outdoors, then Woodstock has something to offer you!

This was recognized by the readers of Blue Ridge Outdoors Magazine in 2019 when they selected Woodstock as The Top Adventure Town in the Mid-Sized Town category, beating out other cities in the eastern United States.

If you are a mountain biker or hiker you will be amazed by the trails in Woodstock. With 30 miles of single track, regarded among the best in the Southeast, mountain bikers, trail runners, and hikers are flocking to the trails at Olde Rope Mill Park and Blankets Creek MTB Park. Woodstock also features several miles of paved trail which are perfect for casual walks and jogs.

If you enjoy the water then be sure to visit Olde Rope Mill Park, a beautiful riverside park in Woodstock. There you will discover a deck overlooking Little River which is a great fishing spot and the park also features a canoe and kayak launch site. Also in the area is Lake Allatoona, a 12,000 acre lake that offers great boating, swimming, and fishing opportunities.

Throughout downtown, you will discover a beautiful sculpture garden, a collection of quirky art benches, and a brand new mural that depicts Woodstock's past and future.



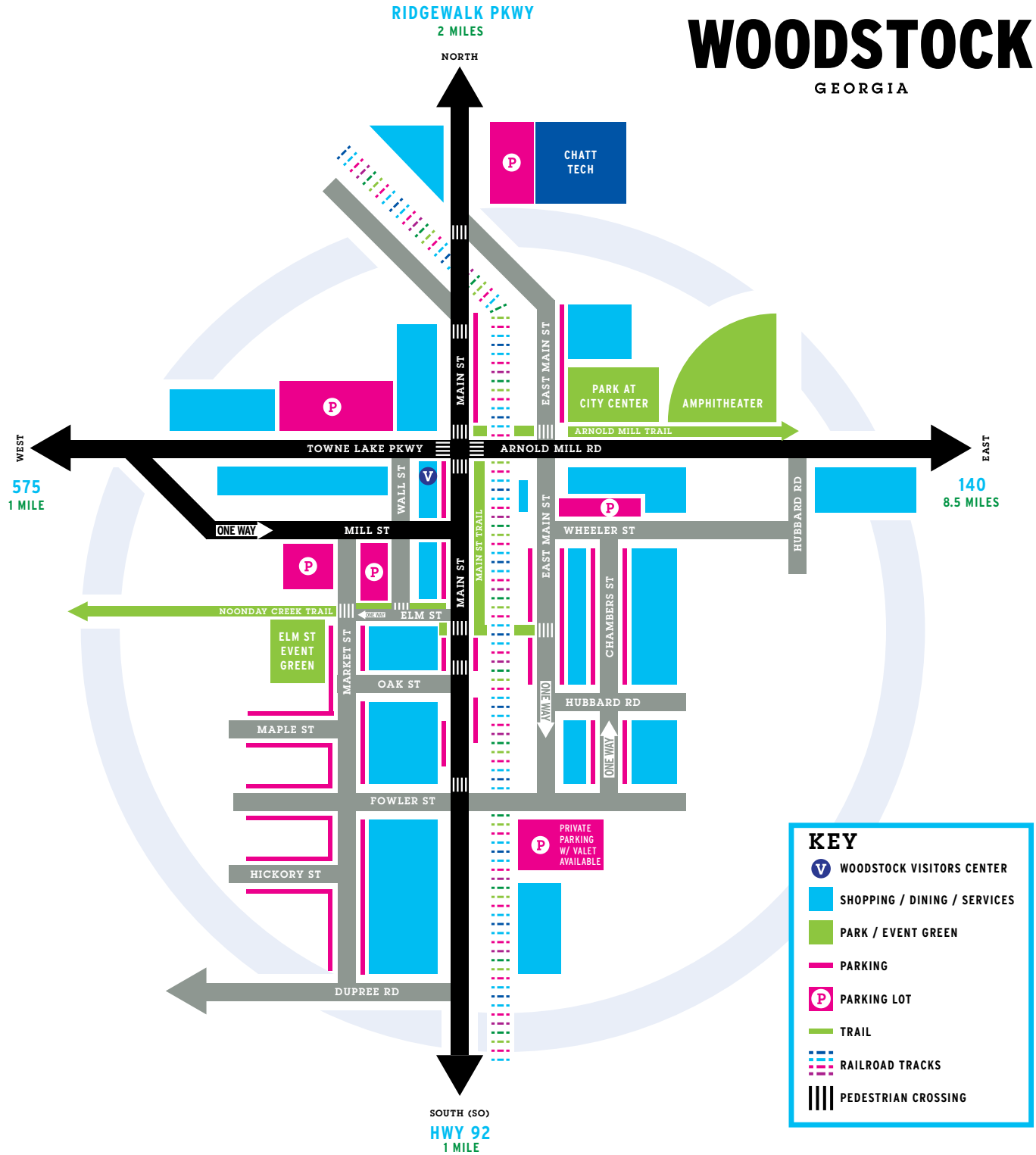
Points of Interest



• In historic Downtown Woodstock you can explore the history of Woodstock. Although the first settlers in the area in the early 1830s called their new home “Woodstock,” the village would not become an official city until 1897. Early settlements were near waterways, but after the railroad and its depot became a reality in 1879, the town centered around these landmarks. Historic storefronts still line Main Street in Downtown Woodstock and are now home to many great shops and restaurants. The Woodstock Train Depot, circa 1912, is located alongside Main Street and is on the National Register of Historic Places.

- At historic Dixie Speedway you can enjoy over four hours of high speed excitement at an affordable price. Georgia’s premier clay oval track, Dixie celebrated their 50th anniversary in 2019. Dixie hosts stock car racing on Saturdays, May-October.
- The Northside Hospital-Cherokee Amphitheater is home to the Woodstock Summer Concert Series and many other major festivals and events in Downtown Woodstock. For more information on the concert series check out WoodstockConcertSeries.com.

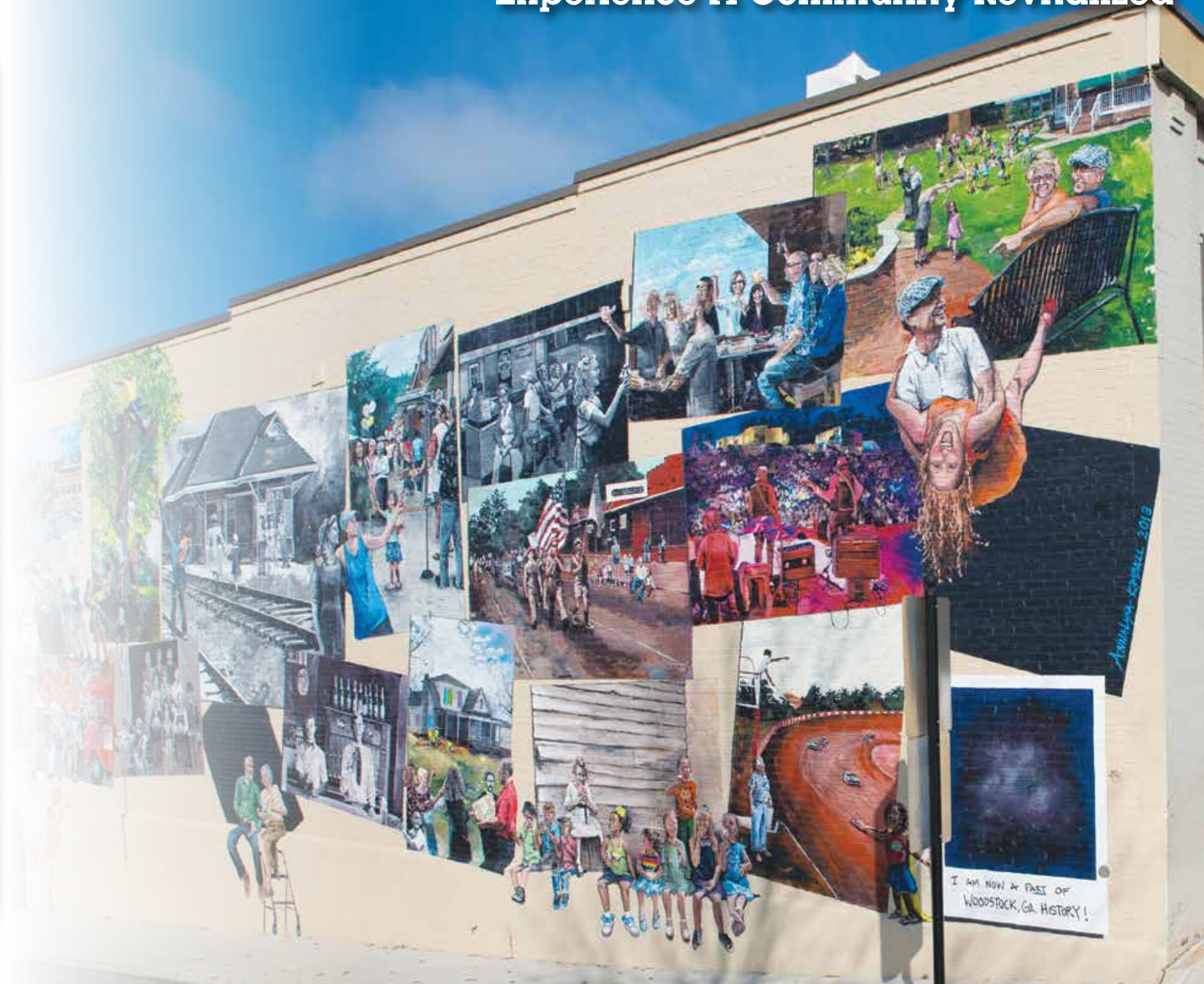

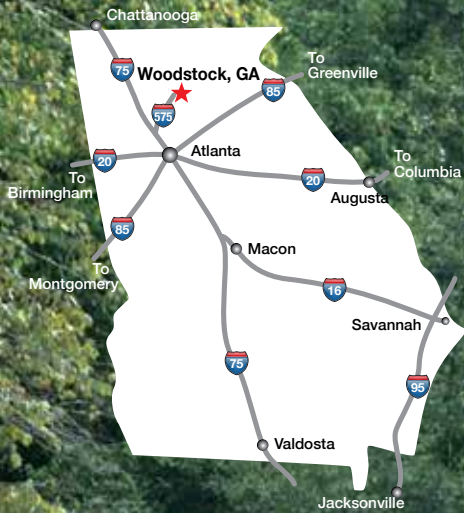
