

The Discover Woodstock Scavenger Hunt is a free activity that will take participants on a journey through Woodstock. This event consists of 100 challenges where the participants must take creative photos of various things. We understand that you may not finish all 100, so challenges are scored by degree of difficulty. Choose wisely!!!

Submissions will be accepted throughout the scavenger hunt, March 22nd- April 27th, at the Woodstock Visitors Center (Mon-Sat 10am- 5pm). The last day to turn in your scavenger hunt results is Saturday April 27th. Bring your pictures downloaded to a USB/Flash Drive to turn in at the Visitors Center. Judges will examine pictures to score the scavenger hunt results. You may also bring hard copies to be scored if you prefer.

<u>Rules</u>

- When you turn your results in, a team name is required for scoring
- No repeat photos. Each clue needs to be solved with a unique photo
- No combining multiple tasks into one photo.
- Every member of a team must be in each photo except the member taking the photo (no dividing and conquering)
- Be respectful in everything you do.
- Respect private property.
- Follow all traffic laws, federal & local laws.
- Be Creative!!!
- Have Fun!!!

Photos worth 1 point

- Take a selfie with your team at Branches Boutique in front of a wall of branches.
- While visiting the Visitors Center find a locally themed beverage that is nice and cool and take a pic with it
- Strike a yoga pose on front of Ember Hot Yoga
- A location related to Truck & Tap at the Outlet Shoppes at Atlanta
- · At the Daily Draft take a picture in front of the "Beer AF Wall"
- Walking on the Noonday Creek Trail under a bridge that takes people to Woofstock Park.
- Team selfie in front of the entrance to Dare to be Different
- In front of the building where Woodstock City Council Meetings take place
- With the Avalanche Trailhead sign.
- Strike a fashionable pose in front of the cupcake cutie sign inside this sweet downtown boutique.
- By a sign for a boutique at Adair Park
- Point out Dixie Speedway on the mural on Mill Street

- With a sign for Depot Square.
- While visiting the Woodstock Beer Market take a photo with a bartender or coffee crew member.
- With wind chimes at Woofstock Park

- Feeling Fancy? Look no further. Strike a pose in front of the stunning historic brick building adorned with elegant white columns. This iconic establishment is none other than the renowned salon and spa, proudly serving its clientele for a remarkable 33 years.
- With a Monopoly themed game at Stars & Strikes
- Check out this Rustic shopping destination and while you are there take a picture inside.
- Selfie in front of the Reformation Silo
- With a statue that pilgrims would be a fan of in Downtown
- · In front of the downtown storefront that is a home to local Makers
- By the outdoor fireplace at Adair Park
- Sitting on a dragonfly bench in downtown
- With a Crayon Change Machine at the Outlet Mall
- At Madisonn Ave you will find something that is big and blue and there's a light that shines on you when you're in it. Take a pic with this object.
- Disc Golf Starting Point 6 at Dupree Park
- Take a selfie at the "coolest" place in town and tag @PelicansWoodstock on social media
- By a cactus on a downtown sidewalk
- In front of a downtown business named in honor of a Georgia island

Photos worth 2 points

- Barbershop pole at South on Main
- Point out the word "hope" on a mural in downtown
- Playing an arcade game at The Blue Ghost
- Enjoying a picnic at the Park at City Center.
- The chef at Reel Seafood makes some tasty food, that is worthy of a picture. Take a selfie with Reel's chef.
- Holding a teddy bear by the Bear Trail Sign at Dupree Park
- Make a heart symbol with your hands while on the pedestrian bridge that takes you over Little River at Olde Rope Mill Park
- At the Woodstock Visitors Center you will find a rack card promoting a very Strange destination. Not all are brave enough to visit this Thing. Take a pic with the correct rack card to complete this challenge
- On a sidewalk near the Woodstock Library you will find a sign with the City of Woodstock & Cherokee County on it. Take a pic with this sign.

- Shopping at the Woodstock Farm Fresh Market
- I'm the first thing you see.... Standing in front of a cherry blossom tree... Come take a picture with me Before you eat sushi in Downtown Woodstock
- With Historical Sign #3 by Preservation Woodstock at Olde Rope Mill Park
- At the end of the Rubes Creek Trail you will discover a big circle. To celebrate give us a Thumbs Up in a pic at this spot
- Moped Parking Only sign near The Manual and Board & Box
- With a musical piece of public art alongside Elm St
- Take a photo at Deep Roots while giving a "cheers" with a beverage or a king of pops from Deep Roots
- At The Circuit find the Free Throw Line and take a pic pretending you are shooting a basketball.
- This house on the trail is where you seek coffee and art and wonderful treats. We have but one "miniature" ask, Snap a picture with a piece of art here is your only task!
- You can now play Ping Pong at a new spot in Downtown. Take a pic playing Ping Pong at this new outside addition to Downtown.
- Selfie in front of a wind mill on a trail in Woodstock
- This event space on Main St is "where Woodstock gathers" and can accommodate 150 people inside. Take a picture with the sign in front of this location.
- Writing your Scavenger Hunt team name with sidewalk chalk on the paved trail at the end of the Trestle Rock Trail.
- Kids today will have no idea how to make a call with this device at Dean's Store.
- At Reformation find the gnome who wants to "set beer free" and take a pic with him.
- Visiting the Friends of the Library store inside the Woodstock Library
- Walking along the sidewalk in front of the businesses along Chambers St while holding shopping bags from downtown stores
- Holding a sign saying "We Heart Woodstock" in front of the fountain at the Park at City Center. (Team with the best sign as determined by judges will earn an extra 5 bonus points)

- Reading the "In Memory of Ron Grasso" plaque at Dupree Park
- · Selfie in front of the location for the Blue Cat Lodge
- Image of kids stacking rocks on Mill Street.
- Point out an image of a Water Mill at The Circuit.
- Playing Pickle Ball or Tennis at the courts at Dupree Park
- US Coast & Geodetic survey benchmark at the historic site of the livery stable in downtown
- Ginkgo Tree Plaque at the Park at City Center
- On a downtown storefront you will see the mark for the Rome Machine & Foundry Co. Take a pic with it
- Disc Golf Hole 9 at Dupree Park
- Enjoy the music at a Lantern Series Concert. Take a pic on the green while enjoying the music
- With a "Buddy On Dream Street" at the Outlet Shoppes
- Marker 900 on the Powerhouse Trail
- Spinning a frisbee on your finger by the Skills sign on the trails at Dupree Park
- 1996 2nd Grade Class Brick at the Park at City Center
- Enjoying the season opening race at Dixie Speedway

- At Kilwins you will find many tasty treats! One shares a name with a college team's name/mascot. Take a picture with this treat.
- Jumping rope on the stage at the Northside Hospital Cherokee Amphitheater
- Marker 540 on the Explorer Trail
- Find a sign on the Towne Lake Pass Trail with "1613" on it
- At Dean's Store you will find an item that once transported 5 lbs of items from Hormel. Take a picture with this.
- Find a sign for a downtown brewery on the Rubes Creek Trail
- With a plaque from Norfolk Southern Railroad in downtown.
- On a piece of public art in Downtown you can spot "SUR" on the art. Take a selfie in front of this specific piece of public art.
- Marker 300 on the Avalanche Trail.
- Strike a cool pose with everyone wearing sunglasses on the bridge that takes you over Noonday Creek on the Noonday Creek Trail.
- Find a photo of Dr T. J. Van Sant on display in Downtown Woodstock. You can see this pic 24/7. Point out this "picture" in your picture.
- With marker 940 on the Raceway trail
- At Holly Springs Jewelers don't be "fooled" by this mineral. Take a pic with it at the store to prove this clue didn't fool you.
- Take a selfie with a cast member from a Woodstock Arts Improv Show
- With the "like the trail bell" on the Powerhouse Trail
- With a marble plaque at a City of Woodstock Park that lists the mayor and city council members in 1989
- Flashing a peace sign by a truck bed bridge on the Avalanche Trail.
- Find a bottle from the Hodges Drug Co on the Dean's Store shelves.
- Bowling at Stars & Strikes.
- On the Explorer Trail at a tight turn you will see a Rock Wall. Within 25 steps on the trail you will see a dead tree. Take a pic with this tree.

Bonus Points

Be sure to include your team name in the post so we know which team to give the bonus points to. 10 bonus points will be added if

A team turns in a video they took during the scavenger hunt. Video should be turned in with usb drive with photos from Scavenger Hunt. Video should focus on why your team loves Woodstock and why people should visit Woodstock. Video should be between 30 seconds and 2 minutes long. The best videos will have a chance to earn extra bonus points. Videos will be judged on creativity, quality, and overall awesomeness. The top 3 videos selected by judges will be awarded extra bonus points. Best Video will earn 25 extra bonus points, 2nd best will earn 15 extra bonus points and 3rd best will earn 10 extra bonus points
