

The Discover Woodstock Scavenger Hunt is a free activity that will take participants on a journey through Woodstock. This event consists of 100 challenges where the participants must take creative photos of various things. We understand that you may not finish all 100, so challenges are scored by degree of difficulty. Choose wisely!!!

Submissions will be accepted throughout the scavenger hunt, March 28th- April 19th, at the Woodstock Visitors Center (Mon-Sat 10am- 5pm). The last day to turn in your scavenger hunt results is Saturday April 19th. Bring your pictures downloaded to a USB/Flash Drive to turn in at the Visitors Center. Judges will examine pictures to score the scavenger hunt results. You may also bring hard copies to be scored if you prefer.

#### **Rules**

- · When you turn your results in, a team name is required for scoring
- No repeat photos. Each clue needs to be solved with a unique photo
- No combining multiple tasks into one photo.
- Every member of a team must be in each photo except the member taking the photo (no dividing and conquering)
- Be respectful in everything you do.
- Respect private property.
- Follow all traffic laws, federal & local laws.
- Be Creative!!!
- Have Fun!!!

- Relaxing on a bench along Little River on the Trestle Rock Trail

- At the Hubbard Street Entrance of the Parking Deck pointing out the sign at the entrance that shows the number of parking spots currently available
- Take a selfie with a staff member at the Woodstock Visitors Center.
- New Orleans is their original home..they feature macarons, gelato and even chocolate domes. Espresso in the morning or late-night treat, come inside for a quick selfie - the mirrors, the lighting, and the perfect sweets!
- In front of the newest seafood restaurant in downtown at Adair Park
- Saluting the flag in front of the Chambers at City Center
- With the Bob The Turkey Statue
- A few artsy benches are located in Downtown Woodstock. Sit back, relax and take a picture in one.
- Seems like a destination to visit? But spelled slightly different then the destination in NYC. Take a pic in front of this downtown boutique.
- · At mural in the new parking deck that depicts a variety of fruits & veggies
- · Sitting in the green chairs at Depot Square
- Reading the 2025 Georgia Travel Guide at the Woodstock Visitors Center
- Walking on a downtown sidewalk with shopping bags from a downtown store.
- Disc Golf Hole 18 at Dupree Park
- At Pie Bar I keep things frozen, fresh, and neat, With pies so savory, hard to beat. Find me, snap me, strike a grin, Your scavenger hunt's about to win! Take a selfie in front of this cool spot inside of Pie Bar
- Holding a pair of Woodstock Socks at the Woodstock Visitors Center.
- Take a picture with an employee in front of the 4Ever Young sign
- Shopping at the Outlet Shoppes at Atlanta
- · With a book you want to read at The Sweet Read
- In front of the Mary F Kish Center
- Checking out the books at the Little Free Library on the Towne Lake Pass Trail
- Making a heart shape with your hands in front of the mural on the side of the Woodstock Pharmacy
- Take a photo in a yoga pose inside Ember in their Boutique for yoga apparel
- Team Selfie at the riverside deck at Rope Mill Park

- Come inside the Woodstock Beer Market and take a picture with an employee with your favorite product from their store.
- On the 5th floor of the parking deck you will find a turtle in a new mural.
- With the Wales Visible Adding and Listing Machine at the Woodstock Visitors Center
- Pose with the largest piece of art as part of a temporary exhibit about "healing", currently available to see throughout the scavenger hunt at The Reeves House
- At the Trestle Rock trailhead sign
- Relaxing on a hammock at the playground in Downtown Woodstock
- · In front of a new flower shop on Main St
- Relaxing at the spot between Canyons & Pure
- Swallowtail Butterfly Garden sign at Woofstock Park

- · Avalanche Trailhead sign
- Throwing a frisbee at the Park at City Center
- Take a pic at the location where the scarecrow for the 2nd place winner in the public vote in 2024 Woodstock Scarecrow Invasion was located during the scarecrow invasion
- Find the Bear Trailhead sign at Dupree Park
- In front of the lockers at The Circuit
- At the plaque highlighting the historic site of the Jail in Woodstock
- · Using a piece of fitness equipment at the workout station at Dupree Park
- You might be surprised to learn that it rains inside at Made Mercantile. Take a
  picture inside Made showing the exact spot you can see this weather
  phenomena occur.
- Salon W Parkside sign on the Noonday Creek Trail
- Selfie Time in front of the colorful sign that welcomes you to Downtown Woodstock across the street from South on Main
- On a sidewalk along Main Street you will see two benches in a circle beneath a "Prime" spot to get your nails done. Take a picture in front of benches.
- A fish has been spotted in Downtown Woodstock saying "Woodstock". Take a
  picture with this fish.
- Moore's Pass Trail Sign

- Point out "Dig" at The Circuit
- Grab Your Selfie With The Brightest MadLife Tophat Musician in the lobby at MadLife
- 0.7 mile sign on the Rubes Creek Trail
- Summer is Coming! Travel Opportunities abound in Georgia. Find a bookshelf at this downtown shoppe featuring Stay-cations and a "friend" to the hound!
- At Preservation Woodstock sign #1 at Rope Mill Park
- Playing Iceball FX at Stars & Strikes
- Feeling fancy? Strike a pose in front of this stunning historic brick building with elegant white columns. It has been a haven of beauty and luxury for 34 years, making this renowned salon and spa a true community gem.
- At a Mountain Bike Trail Map located next to a parking lot a Rope Mill Park.
- Take a picture of your team coming in and solving the Mathnasium Problem of the Week
- Pink Pearl Hero sign on the Noonday Creek Trail
- Pointing out the Cherokee County Historical Society Brick at the Reeves House.
- Enjoying a picnic in front of the Gazebo at the Park at City Center
- Using your library card to check something out at the Woodstock Public Library
- Turbine Trailhead Sign at Rope Mill Park
- In front of a movie poster at the Regal Cherokee Movie Theater
- Find a bottle of Willard's Tablets on the shelves at Dean's Store.
- Find Bunker the Bear at Reformation and take a picture with him. As you look for the statue at Reformation keep in mind that Bunker will be wearing Reformation merch.

# **Photos worth 3 points**

- Dropping off a donation to the Little Free Pantry behind the Woodstock Visitors Center.
- At a lighthouse at the Woodstock Community Garden
- In front of the downtown storefront that was the site for a movie theater over 70 years ago
- · With a piece of public art in downtown that has "Sutter 1989" on it
- "One Wheel Woodstock" on a sign on the Rubes Creek Trail

- Discover the spot where you can see "gears" on the upper level sidewalk along Main Street.
- As you make your way along a gravel path to the Explorer Trail take a picture with a Trail Sign with a Black Arrow and Trail written on both sides of the arrow
- Take a picture of the Reel Glass with the Bartender or Chef but it has to be the new REEL glass that is Blue & White
- While in the audience for the "Rock The Boat Cabaret" show, take a picture with the playbill to show you attended this Woodstock Arts production.
- Enjoying a meal at your favorite restaurant in Downtown Woodstock.
- At the horse shoe pits at Dupree Park
- 0.2 miles to Downtown Woodstock on a sign on the Noonday Creek Trail
- You might be able to follow a bird to it's home that was built by Christopher Pedersen for a Eagle Scot Project. This bird house is located along side a paved trail in Woodstock.
- Christopher Brazelton can be found in a mural along Mill Street. Take a picture with the mural depiction of Christopher.
- Get a connect 4 while playing Connect 4 Hoops at Stars & Strikes
- Point out a QR code sign for Woodbird at the Woodstock Visitors Center
- Find the Cherokee County Animal Shelter on the directory sign at the Outlet Shoppes at Atlanta
- A street in Downtown Woodstock is named in the honor of Woodstock's first female mayor. Point out the street sign for the correct street.
- With the Optimist Club of South Cherokee Brick at the Park at City Center.
- Picture time with a jazz duo/trio while viewing art at the Reeves House
- Disc Golf Starting Point 14 at Dupree Park
- Your next clue is where health meets convenience, Across from Target, a prime location indeed! Aylo believes staying well should be simple and clear, Because healthy people do amazing things here! Find the sign on the top floor, right inside the entryway. Take a selfie, earn your points, and have a great day!
- Lynn & Manny sign on the Rubes Creek Trail
- Find a Rhino on a kids ride at the Outlet Shoppes at Atlanta
- 500 trail marker sign on the Explorer Trail
- You might be surprised to learn that an Eastern Hercules Beetle is depicted in a piece of public art in Downtown Woodstock. Be sure to point it out when you find it!

- Along the Towne Lake Pass Trail a "cafe" is depicted on a sign along the trail. Point out the "cafe" on this trailside sign.
- Say "Yes...and" while posing with some improv artists following a live improv show at Woodstock Arts.
- Nine ways to boost your health and feel great, From cooling recovery to heat that rejuvenates.Relax, recover, and enhance your might, Find the elements that keep you feeling right! Take a pic in front of a map in the IV Room at a downtown business that will Restore you
- Checking at the Raceway structure by the dam at Rope Mill Park
- Pose at concert occurring on the Green, where the artists are from South America.
- Find a Pink 5 on a tree at Dupree Park along a trail
- At Historic Dean's Store you will see the spot where Sterling Silver Friendship Rings use to be stored. Be sure to point this out so we know you found the correct spot.
- With a Yellow Arrow on a fallen tree alongside a trail at Dupree Park
- Playing an arcade game at The Blue Ghost
- With a plaque with "Nov 12 2016" on it at the Park at City Center
- 700 trail sign at Rope Mill Park
